ARRIVING FROM THE **AIRPORT**

Getting to the city from Kaunas Airport is quite an easy task and nowhere near the challenge it used to be. Karmėlava airport is **located 16km north of the city centre**. Once formalities are out the way, you can find several information kiosks open for advice on reaching Kaunas and ATMs for cash.



Bus N°29G stops outside to the left. **Single ticket is just 1€**: buy it from the bus driver and you'll be in the centre **in less than 30 minutes**. You can also download ZIOGAS: register by filling out your details and **get a single ticket for 0.75€**



Taxis are **parked outside the arrivals' hall**. Try to negotiate a fare before setting off and expect **to pay around 15€ for a trip to the city centre**. Another option would be **getting Bolt app**: simply download it, fill out your data and you are all set!

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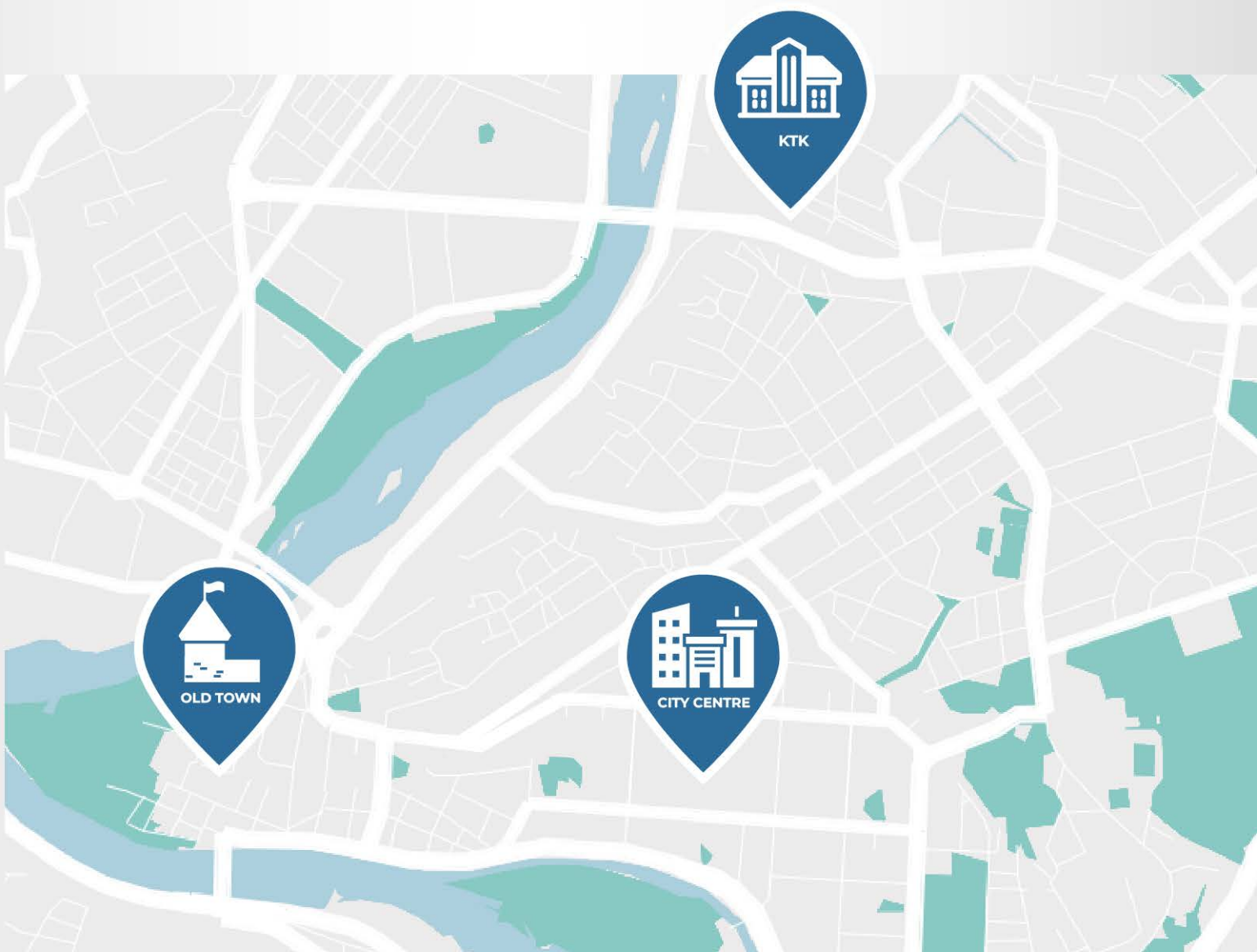
ARRIVAL FROM THE CITY CENTRE TO

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BEST PLACES TO VISIT IN **KAUNAS**

You can beat your museum-visiting record here, as **Kaunas has the largest concentration of museums in Lithuania of sports/ devils/ war/ paintings/ zoology/ aviation/ medicine/ folk instruments/ open-air folk museum/ literature/ atomic bunker/ clowns** and so many more. Here are some of the most famous and most frequently visited places worth seeing:



AB UNDERGROUND PRINTING HOUSE

It is a perfectly preserved space hidden under a greenhouse where several brave Lithuanians printed and distributed illegal literature during the last decade of the Soviet occupation.



CHRIST'S RESURRECTION CHURCH

The place which a history of slow construction. Whether you're an atheist or a believer, this stunning Art Deco masterpiece is a Kaunas bucket list essential.



NINTH FORT MUSEUM

A mass Holocaust murder site, the Ninth Fort is worth the effort it takes to get there. Visit the museum for some shocking information about the fort's grim history.



VMU KAUNAS BOTANICAL GARDEN

It is a top Kaunas sight worth visiting for lots of fresh air and fauna galore. Come to see spacious green area with the old park, picturesque ponds and peculiar buildings. Take a stroll and enjoy beautiful views!



VYTAUTAS THE GREAT WAR MUSEUM

Possibly one of the best museums in Kaunas, where you can see and have an entire history lesson under one roof.
